

Three-Year Canopy Plan

At the RMC canopy informational meeting on September 19, 2018, RMC outlined a three-year plan to address trees that are overhanging roadways or blocking the sight lines for drivers. If trees or shrubs are determined to be in the right-of-way (up to 10 feet from the edge of the road), the RMC will determine what will be trimmed or removed, with the advice from Kilpatrick's Tree Service. Trees that are farther than 10 feet from the roadway, but hanging out over the road will on average, be trimmed to a height of 15-30 feet. Exact cutting will be determined by Kilpatrick's, keeping the integrity of the canopy.

Phase 1 of the project includes Kenmure Drive and Winding Meadows. Work will begin on Monday, September 24, and continue for approximately two weeks.

Phase 2 includes the area of Overlook Drive, Poplar Loop, and surrounding streets. This work will be done in the fall of 2019.

Phase 3 includes the area of Tarnhill Drive, up through the Pinnacle Peak areas. This work is planned for the fall of 2020.

At any time, it is determined that specific trees or areas need to be addressed, that are not in our original plan, we will adjust the targeted areas.
