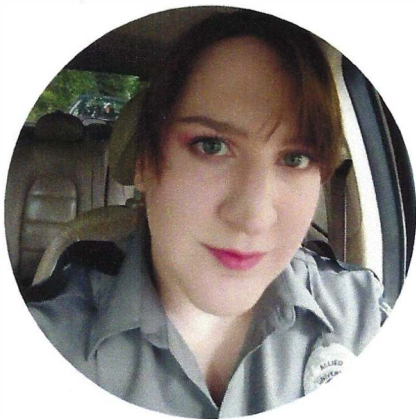


Security Team Spotlight
